

Medicare Advantage plan changes

September 2025

For current Samaritan Medicare Advantage plan members, you can choose a new plan after Oct. 15, 2025, through Dec. 7, 2025. You will have a special enrollment to choose a new plan through Feb. 28, 2026, but it is recommended you select a new plan before this date.

You have three choices to change plans

- 1. Join another Medicare Advantage plan between Oct. 15, 2025, and Dec. 7, 2025.
- 2. Change to Original Medicare with a standalone prescription drug plan (PDP).
 - You will still have Medicare Parts A (Hospital) and B (Medical) but will need to add a Part D plan (PDP/Prescription Drug Plan).
- 3. Change to Original Medicare with a standalone prescription drug plan (PDP) and enroll in a Medigap (Medicare Supplement) plan.
 - You will still have Medicare Parts A (Hospital) and B (Medical) but will need to add a Part D plan (PDP/Prescription Drug Plan).
 - With this choice, you would also add a Medigap (Medicare Supplement) plan.

To enroll in a Medicare Advantage plan, beneficiaries can

- 1. Visit Medicare.gov plan finder to search for a new plan.
 - You can enroll in a new plan on Medicare.gov.

To enroll in a standalone prescription drug plan

- 1. Visit Medicare.gov plan finder to search for a new plan.
 - You can enroll in a new plan on Medicare.gov.

To enroll in a Medigap (Medicare Supplement) plan

Visit <u>Medicare.gov plan finder</u> to compare Medigap plans. There are a few ways you can enroll in a Medigap plan:

- 1. Call the plan directly.
 - Visit Medicare.gov
 - After entering your zip code, select Medigap policy and then click Find Plans.
 - Enter all requested information to get more accurate prices.
 - Select which plan you are interested in and click View Policies.
 - Each plan listing will have the company contact information.
- 2. Calling a Medicare insurance agent
 - Visit Oregon SHIBA's website to find licensed insurance agents.
 - Under Find Local Help, select Medicare Agents and enter your zip code. This will
 provide a list of insurance agents in your area.

Please note that Oregon SHIBA can provide basic Medigap information and provide limited information on various Medigap plans but cannot enroll you into a Medigap policy.
